Homayoun Zhaveh and Sara Ahmadi

Homayoun, a Christian convert with advanced Parkinson's disease, and his wife, Sara, have been handed prison sentences of 2 years and 8 years, respectively. They were first arrested in 2019 and detained. Sara was detained for 67 days, including 33 in solitary confinement – mostly within the Intelligence Ministry's Ward 209 – during which time she was subjected to extreme psychological torture. In 2021, they were called to begin their prison sentences. Now they must face years in prison. Would you pray for this Christian couple?
