On February 19, 2018, 14-year-old Leah Sharibu was kidnapped by Boko Haram from her school in Dapchi, Nigeria, along with approximately 100 other girls. A month later, every girl was released, except for Leah who remains in captivity because she refused to deny her faith in Jesus Christ. Unfortunately, Leah is just one of hundreds, if not thousands, of missing Christian girls in Nigeria. Please pray for Leah and other girls like her who are being held captive for their faith.

“My God, whom we have been praying to with you, is showing Himself mighty in my trying moment. I know your words to me during our morning devotions that God is very close to people in pain. I am witnessing this now. I am confident that one day I shall see your face again. If not here, then there at the bosom of our Lord Jesus Christ.”
