Nasser Navard Gol-Tapeh was arrested on June 24, 2016, for “Acting against national security.” His crime? Involvement in house churches. On June 22, 2017, he was sentenced to 10 years in prison. Nasser began serving his sentence in notorious Evin Prison on January 20, 2018. He has appealed three times for a retrial, but on each occasion his appeal has been rejected. If Nasser is forced to complete his 10-year sentence, he will be 66 when he is released. Please pray for Nasser.
