On February 13, 2017, Pastor Raymond was abducted in broad daylight when his car was surrounded. He was dragged out and taken away. The incident was caught on a CCTV camera. The National Human Rights Commission of Malaysia determined that he was a victim of enforced disappearance carried out by agents of the state. Unfortunately, Pastor Raymond is still missing, and the government is not fulfilling its promises to locate him. Would you pray for Pastor Raymond, his wife Susanna, and their three adult children?
